- i. Sense of Belonging and Reading Comprehension For all the school community. Teachers were given the freedom to choose which goals to focus on by creating their own SMART goals.
 - 1. **Grade 6s Goals:** Math fraction spiraling (fractions weak for all kids so a focus), sense of belonging and acceptance, social emotional learning, and executive functioning (organization).
 - 2. **Grade 7s Goals:** Sense of belonging, peer connections and goals (having a good friend and being included), reading comprehension, executive functioning being ready to learn, executive functioning checks (binder, locker, etc).
 - 3. **Grade 8's Goals:** Math (general math confidence), sense of belonging and acceptance, spiral math curriculum, classroom community, feedback (co-created), and sense of belonging.
 - CST Goals: Social emotional learning, mental health, tools to support math differentiation (at different levels), and sense of belonging.
