Cold Weather Busing

As we approach winter we want everyone to be aware of the cold weather busing policy for Prairie Spirit School Division: Buses will not run if the combined temperature/wind chill factors result in a reading of -40 degrees Celsius or below at 6:00 a.m. Buses that do not run at the regular time in the morning will not to run at all on that same day even if the temperature warms up. Parking Reminders

*Please do not park where the pylons are set up in our parking loop. We need to keep this area clear for student access.

*For the safety of everyone please make sure students and adults are crossing at the marked crosswalks. *Drivers please take extra caution when driving in front of the school and be aware that things will slow down during the beginning and end of school times.
