



Registering for 2021/2022 Kindergarten

If your child will be five years old by December 31, 2021 (born in 2016) they will be able to attend Kindergarten next year. Please contact one of the schools in our community to leave your child's name and your contact information so that Kindergarten registration materials may be sent to you.

The purpose of our S-P-T conferences is three-fold: Building relationships; Better understanding the strengths and needs of each student; Providing timely feedback that will allow the student to act on this feedback.
