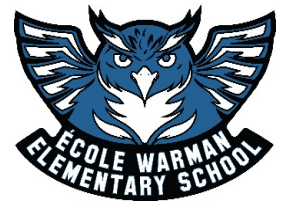
We only have 7 positions filled out of 9, so voting is unnecessary. New members may still join at a later date.

Division - \$4336.89 (What the division allocates, \$2000/yr)

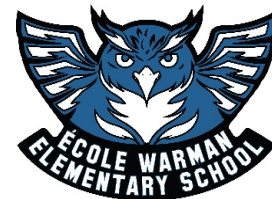
One thing we will discuss at future meetings, is to try to spend money we get the same year we get it. Brandy will pass the spreadsheet on to Seerat (new treasurer).

Hi all,

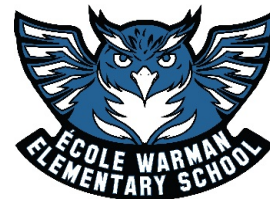

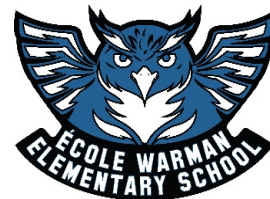
