

STUDENT PICK UP / DROP OFF & PARKING REMINDERS

*For the safety of everyone please make sure student drop off/pickups happen in the **drop off loops** to the West (in front of Before & After School building) or East of our school (behind the staff parking lot – down the alley), in the parking area across from the school or in the alley ways. At **NO TIME** should parents have students meeting them in the staff parking lot.

*Parents must refrain from dropping off or picking up students in the bus lane in the front of the school – even after the buses have pulled away. ÉWES is back to having field trips and buses must stay on schedule, so they must always have access to the bus lanes during the school day. The bylaw officer will be issuing tickets for those continuing to park in non-parking areas and stopping in bus lanes between the hours of 8am – 3:30pm.

- * For the safety of everyone, students and adults should be crossing the street at the marked crosswalks.
- *Drivers please take extra caution when driving in front of the school. Please be aware that things will slow down during the beginning and end of school times.

Prairie Spirit Bus Inclement Weather Policy Reminders

A bus route that is cancelled in the morning due to extreme cold will run in the afternoon, if conditions have improved.

Bus routes cancelled at 6 am due to cold weather will operate on their regular routes at the end of the school day, provided that temperatures reported at 12 noon are warmer than -40 degrees Celsius (combined temperature/windchill). Please see the notes at the end of this message. If the bus will run at the end of the school day, parents will receive notifications through the <u>Versa trans My Stop app</u> and the update will be posted on the Division's <u>website</u> and phone hotline (306-683-2805).

Educational tours and/or extra-curricular travel by bus will operate in the afternoon provided that the temperature reported at 11 am are warmer than -40 degrees Celsius (combined temperature/windchill).

Wheelchair lift equipment will be operational in the afternoon if the combined temperature is above -35 degrees Celsius at 12 noon. The driver will contact the student's family if the lift equipment is operating for the afternoon route.

Notes: • Please see the Division's updated Admin Procedure 805 - Bus Service Cancellation Due to Inclement Weather. The Prairie Spirit Transportation Department uses Environment Canada's data only.

PSSD Learning Summaries Date Change



Due to the Edsby program implementation within the Prairie Spirit School Division, all schools will be moving to common reporting windows and progress report dates for the 2022/2023 school year.

Student Conference dates will remain as scheduled (check your school's calendars); however, the dates that the Learning Summaries will be made available on Edsby are changing.

New Common PSSD Reporting Dates: (Learning Summaries Available on Edsby) ÉWES Grades 1-5:

END of Term 1 = November 25th **NOT** December 2nd

END of Term 2 = March 17th NOT March 23rd

END of Term 3 = June 29th - no changes made

ÉWES Kindergarten:

END of Term 1 = March 16th (A Day) or March 17th (B Day) **NOT** February 15th (A Day) or February 16th (B Day)

END of Term 2 = June 28th (A Day) or June 29th (B Day) – no changes made
