2025 - 2026 SCHOOL YEAR

- Eligible transportation students will be permitted only one bus pass. Families must choose either their primary home address or a daycare location (needs to be a registered stop) for their child's transportation.
- Transportation request must be submitted by June 26, 2025 to be guaranteed busing for September 2, 2025.
- Current urban passes, alternate stop passes and safe haven passes will expire at the end of this school year.
 <u>ALL Students must re-register if they require</u> <u>transportation for the 2025-2026 school year</u>.









CLASSROOM PLACEMENTS FOR 2025/2026

EACH SPRING ÉCOLE WARMAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ENGAGES IN A COMPREHENSIVE PROCESS OF CREATING EQUITABLE HOMEROOM PLACEMENTS FOR THE FOLLOWING SCHOOL YEAR. OUR GOAL IS TO PLACE STUDENTS IN A SETTING THAT IS APPROPRIATE FOR EACH CHILD INDIVIDUALLY AND FOR THE GROUP THAT MAKES THE BEST USE OF OUR STAFF RESOURCES. THE FINAL PLACEMENT OF A CHILD IS A SCHOOL-BASED DECISION THAT IS MADE USING THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- ACADEMIC NEEDS AND SUPPORTS
- SOCIAL NEEDS AND GROUP DYNAMICS
- STUDENTS WHO REQUIRE ADDITIONAL OR INTENSIVE SUPPORTS
- INDEPENDENCE LEVEL
- STUDENT RELATIONSHIPS
